

# Math Around You

In Math Curse, the character sees Math all around her. Your child is being challenged to create a picture that shows a place where he/she sees Math in his/her every day life. Then, write a brief explanation that describes the math in his/her picture.

## Requirements:

Use a 9 ½" x 11" pieces of paper.

Pick an idea and draw a picture that illustrates "Math Around You."

Color the picture using crayons, markers, colored pencils, pastels, paint, etc. (Whatever the adult in charge says is okay.)

On a separate piece of paper write a brief explanation that describes the math in your picture (anywhere from 1-6 sentences) and attach it to the bottom of your picture.

On the back of the paper, write your name—first and last.

Return the picture and writing to your math teacher by Friday, November 18<sup>th</sup>.

## Prize

The students of Beaumont will vote for the 2 pictures (one from K-2 and one from 3-4) that they believe best illustrates and explains "Math Around You."

Those 2 students will have their pictures featured in the Beaumont Blast and on the television in the lobby, as well as win a "Math Box" filled with math goodies.
