

## ***Who Are We?***

Philabundance is the region's largest hunger relief organization. We get food into the hands of people that need it most.

## ***Who Do We Help?***

We work with nearly 500 agencies, including food cupboards, churches, shelters, social service agencies, and emergency kitchens.

Philabundance provides food to approximately 65,000 people per week and 23% of them are kids.

## ***What neighborhoods do we help?***

We help people in 9 counties in the Delaware Valley including: Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery, and Philadelphia Counties in Pennsylvania and Western Burlington, Camden, Gloucester and Salem Counties in New Jersey.

## ***How Do We Move the Food Around?***

We have 10 trucks on the road 5 days a week giving out meat, vegetables, fruits, breads, milk products and canned and packaged foods.

In 2011, we distributed 19 million pounds of food all over the Delaware Valley.
