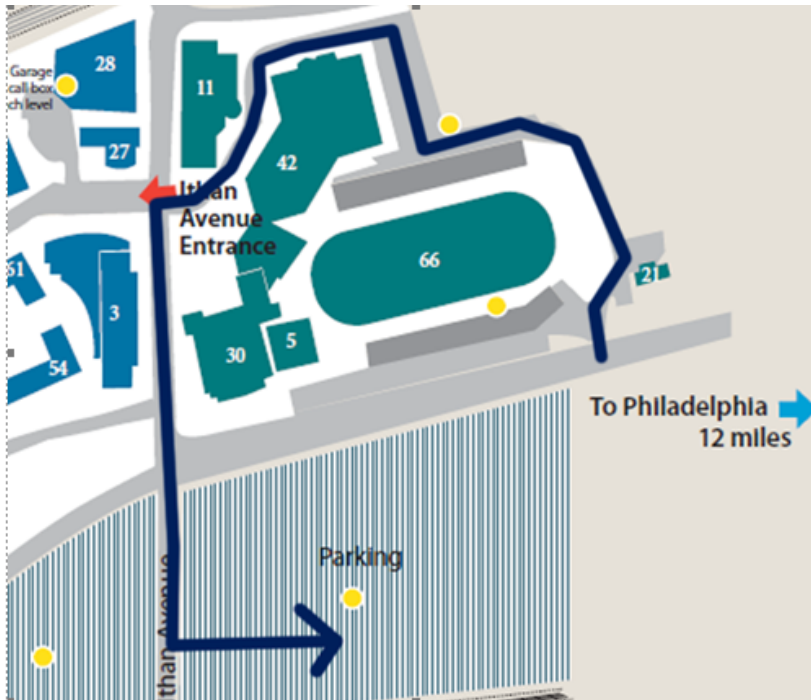

Pick up/Drop off Bus Route



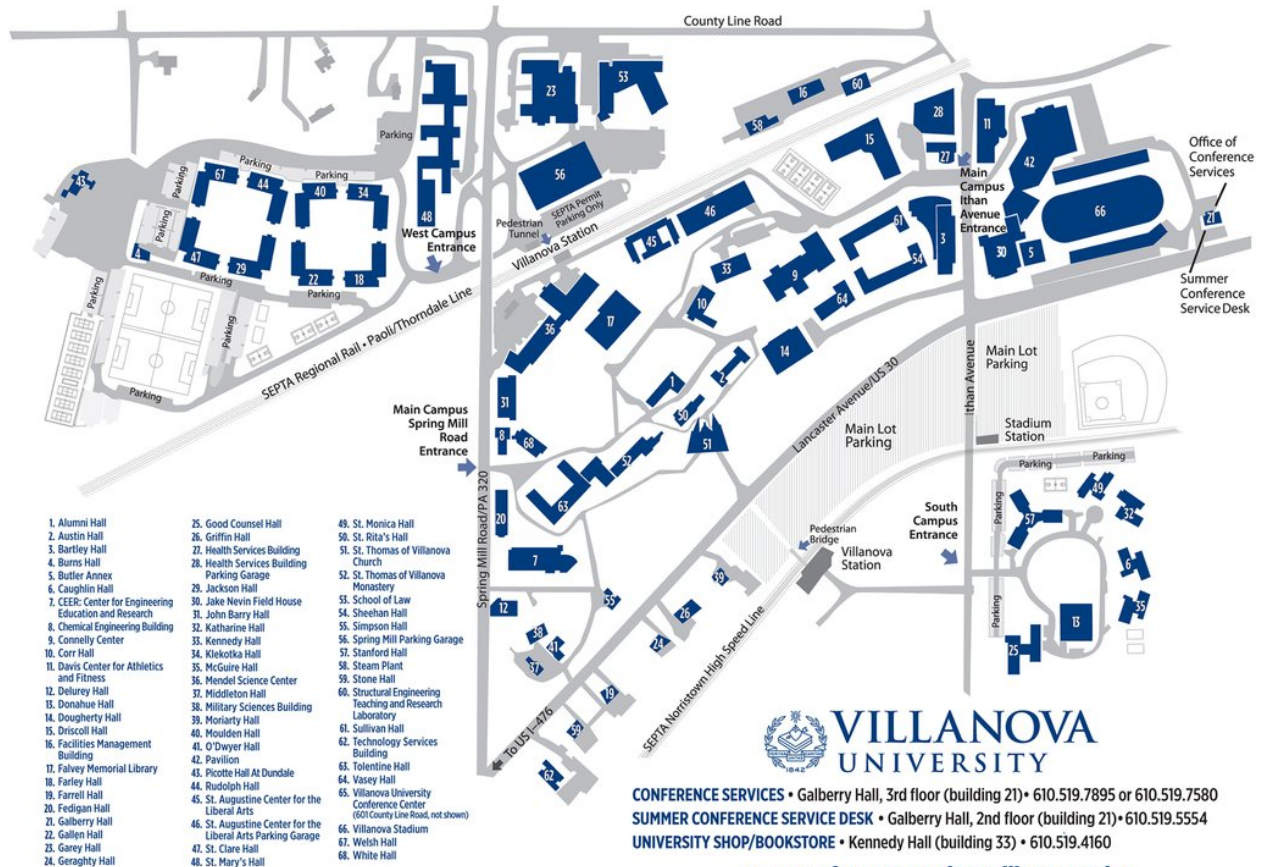
Drop Off/
